Program Manager (Administrator) Description

This WAH course is designed for people directly responsible for the development or maintenance of a fall protection program. This course is for people that do not work at height but are in an authoritative position for an employer and are responsible to eliminate or mitigate fall hazards encountered by staff. Program owners, program administrators, internal auditors, plant managers, competent persons, process owners, and safety professionals often participate in this course. This course includes content and resources to establish or maintain a fall protection program using an online workshop and is maintained through a Continuing Education Program.
